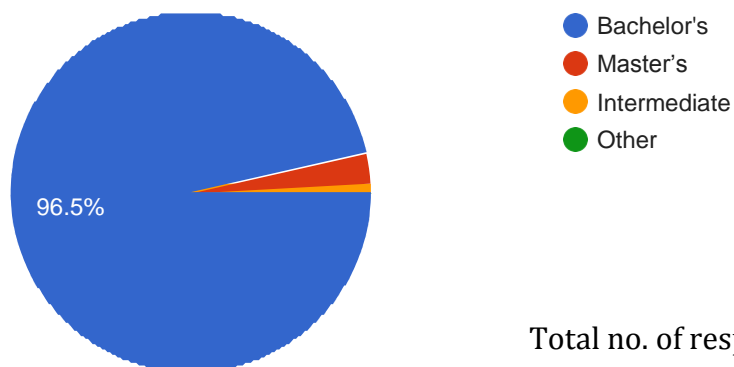

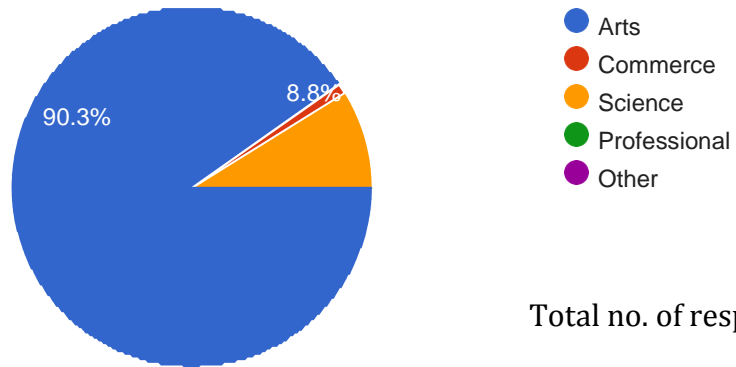

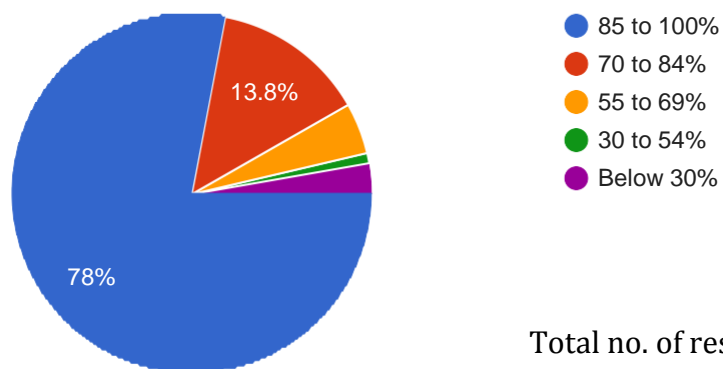

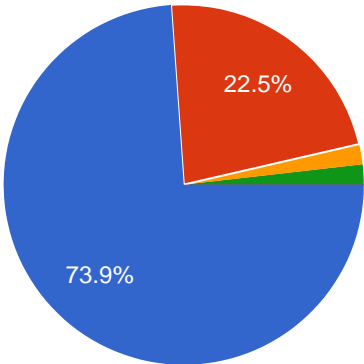

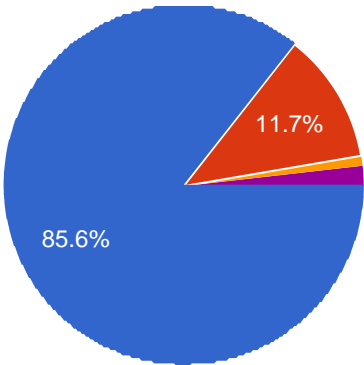

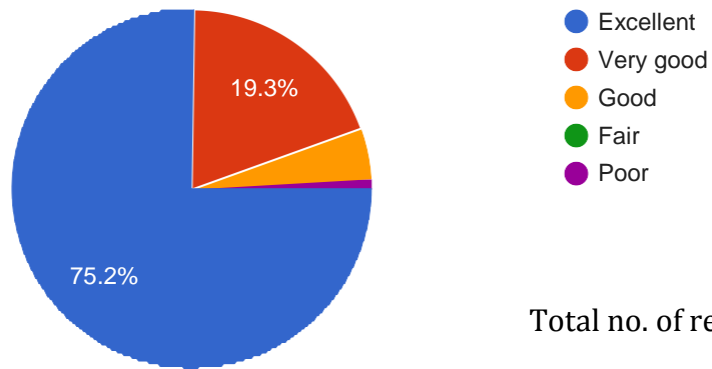

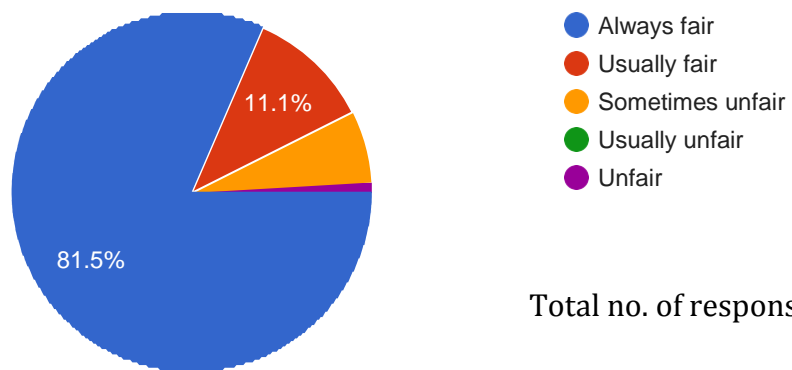

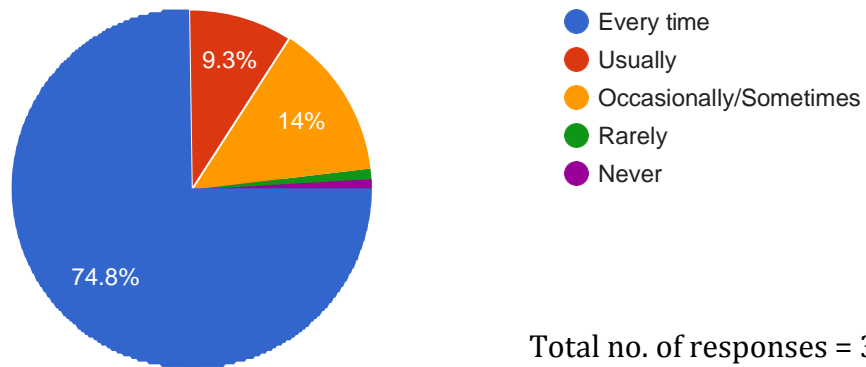

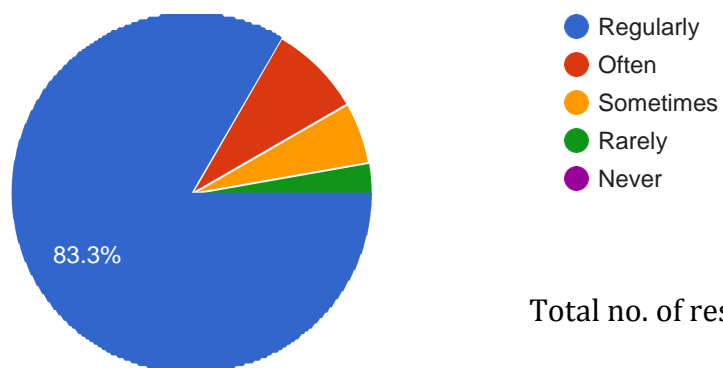

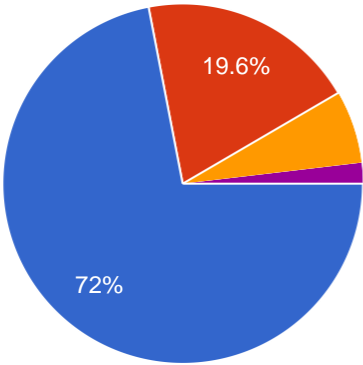

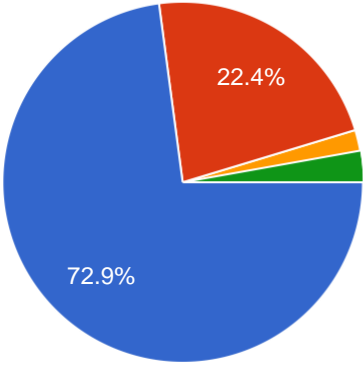

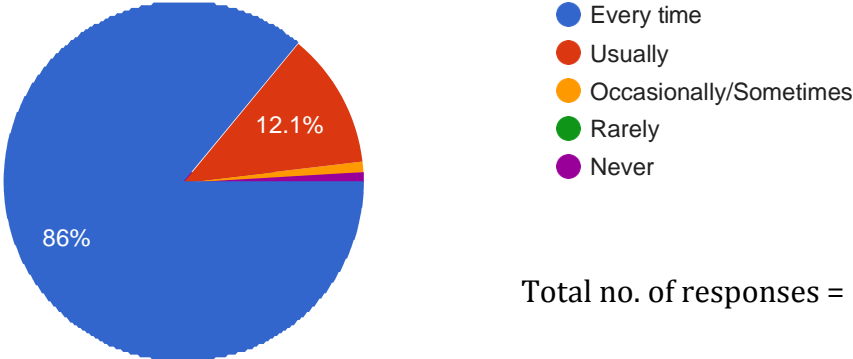

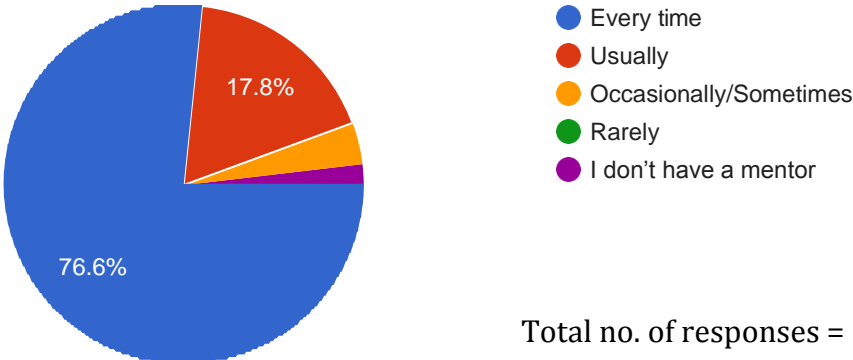

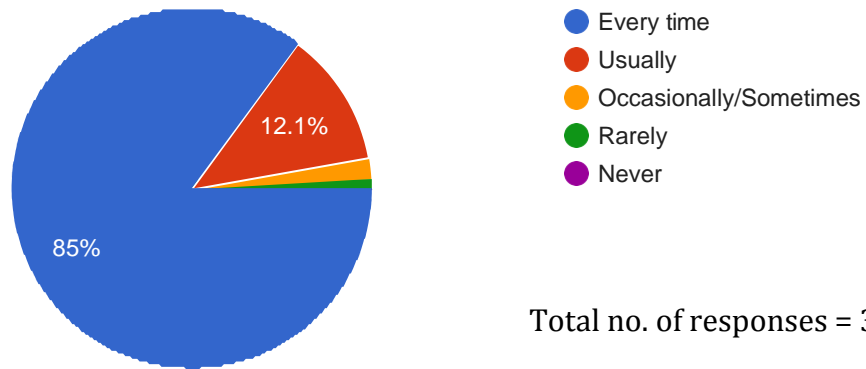

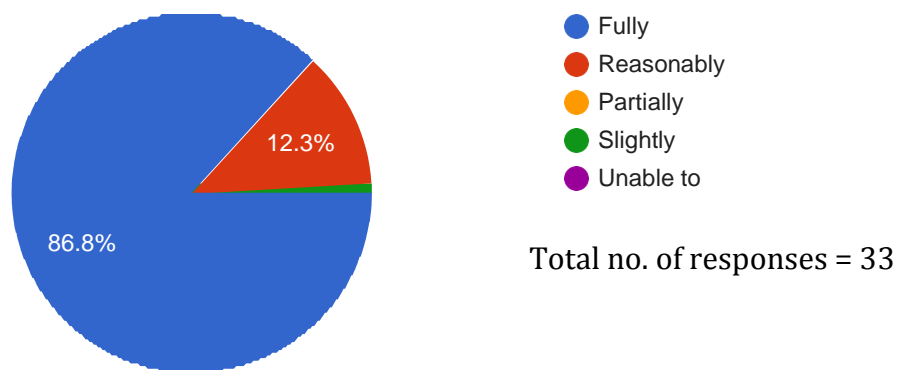

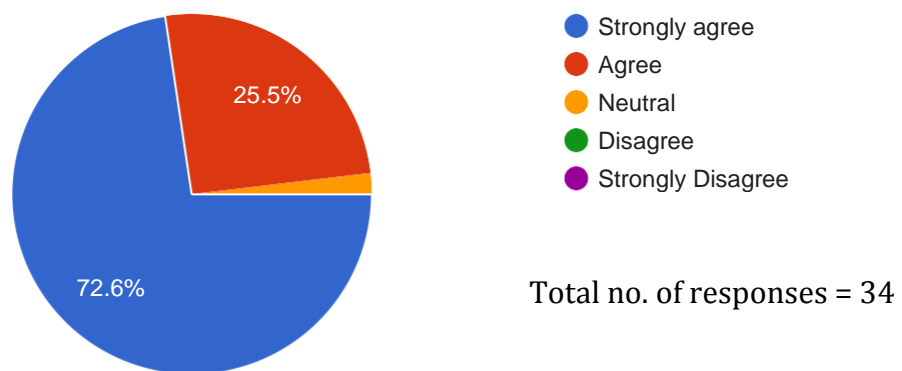

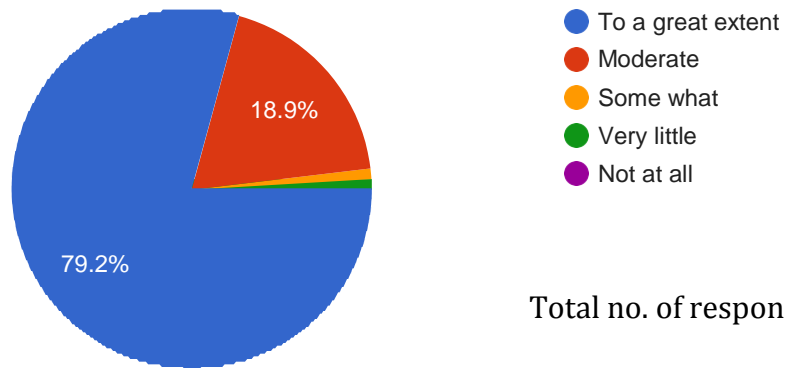

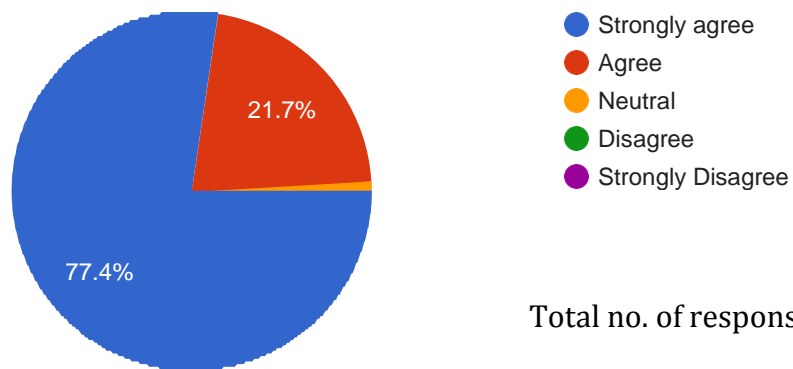

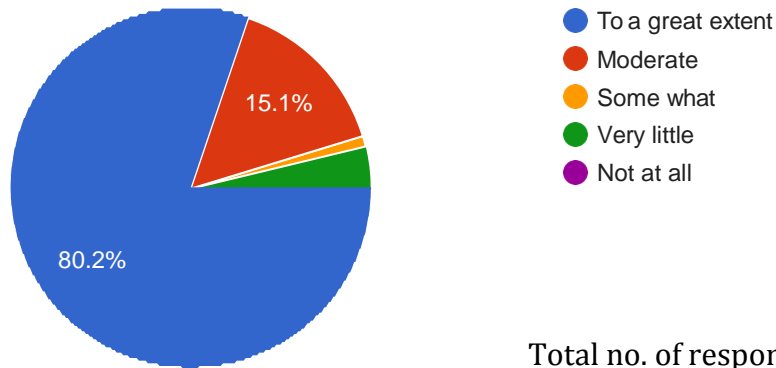
Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

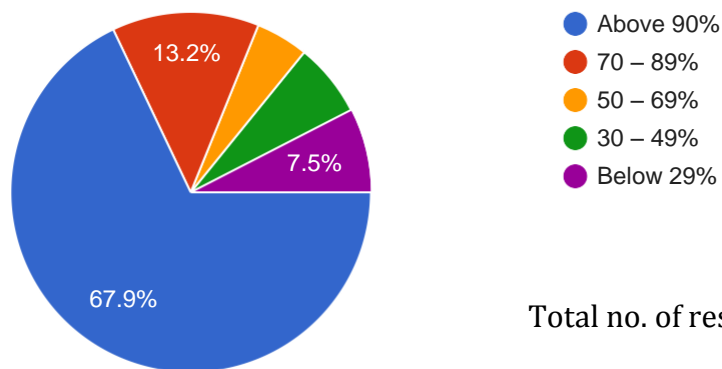

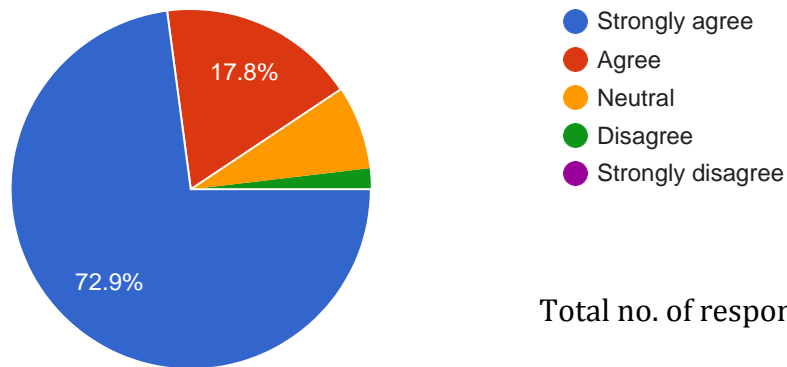
